I want to thank you for making my teaching job more enjoyable and productive. Let me explain.

I have been teaching industrial arts/technology for 37 years at Jasper High School, and most of those years have been spent teaching woodworking. However, when the state of Indiana switched the curriculum to technology, we changed our class to construction. I had a "home-grown" hodgepodge of construction activities including electricity, plumbing, masonry, etc. Your "Construction Zone" workstations and curriculum have done a wonderful job of tying together a complete program that is easy to teach and one the students really love.
